Qualifications:

Applicants for the SeaWorld & Busch Gardens Youth Advisory Council must:

- Be between the ages of 14-20 at the time of application.
- Be a resident of the United States.
- Have a passion for conservation and education.
- Have the ability to work with a team of youth and adults to accomplish common goals.
- Have an interest in providing a youth voice to the work of SeaWorld Parks & Entertainment.

Roles and Responsibilities:

As a member of the SeaWorld & Busch Gardens Youth Advisory Council you will:

- Provide ongoing input to SeaWorld Parks & Entertainment and their partners on topics including education programs, conservation initiatives, marketing/communications, and strategies for engaging youth audiences.
- Serve on at least one Council committee and collaborate with fellow Council members to develop and lead initiatives/projects to support SeaWorld's conservation mission and work.
- Serve as an "Ambassadors for Conservation" in your community by remaining active in local conservation projects/programs and representing SeaWorld at conferences/events as opportunities arise.
- Leverage your peer networks and online platforms to share opportunities for other young people to become involved in SeaWorld's environmental conservation and education programs.
- Oversee the SeaWorld & Busch Gardens Environmental Excellence Awards Program.
